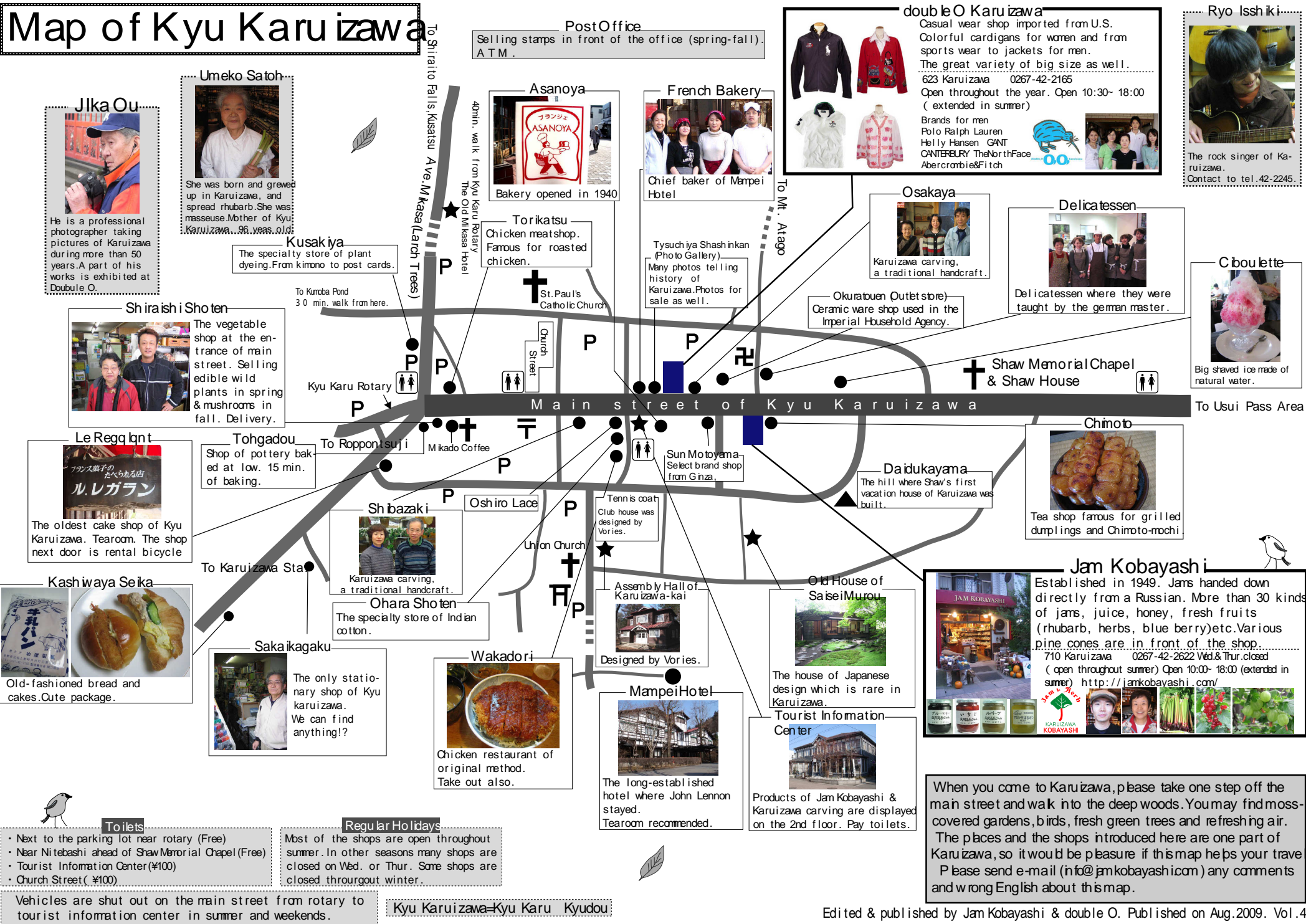


Map of Kyu Karuizawa

Designed by Vories.




Manpei Hotel
